Women, Infants & Children Nutrition Program (WIC)

WIC is a special supplement food program for pregnant, breastfeeding, and post-partum women, infants, and children under five year of age. WIC helps your baby get healthy foods and healthy advice in the first years of life.

If you're eligible for WIC, you'll receive at no cost:

- * A monthly package of delicious, nutritious foods
- * Valuable tips on healthy eating
- * Health care referrals
- * Breastfeeding support

The WIC food package provides nutritious foods to supplement your regular meals. You can choose some or all of the following, free of charge:

- * White and chocolate milks
- * A variety of hot and cold cereals, including infant cereal
- * Eggs
- * Beans
- * A selection of 100% fruit juices, including Infant juices
- * Cheese
- * Canned tuna and carrots for breastfeeding mothers
- * Fresh canned fruits and vegetables
- * Whole wheat bread and tortillas
- * Baby Formula, Baby food fruits and vegetables, Baby food meats for breastfed infants.
- * Peanut Butter
- * To be eligible for the program, a woman, infant, or child must meet the income guidelines and be a medical or nutritional risk. Low iron levels in the blood (anemia), underweight, overweight, or poor diet are typical examples. A nurse or nutritionist will determine if an applicant is eligible for the WIC program.

* Apply in person. Applicants must bring proof of income, residence, and identification to their WIC appointment.
